The Staff Psychologist empowers and builds relationships with employees and provides a confidential avenue to aid them in navigating through professional and personal difficulties by being available and responsive to their needs.

Some travel throughout the state is required for this position with occasional overnight stays.

Your primary duties will consist of providing mental health care/treatment to adult offenders with psychiatric, emotional, cognitive, personality and/or behavioral disorders.

- Supervisory and Career Coaching
- Pre-Employment Psychological Evaluations
- Conflict management / mediation
- Confidential short-term consultation
- Crisis Intervention
